CONNECTED IN FAITH

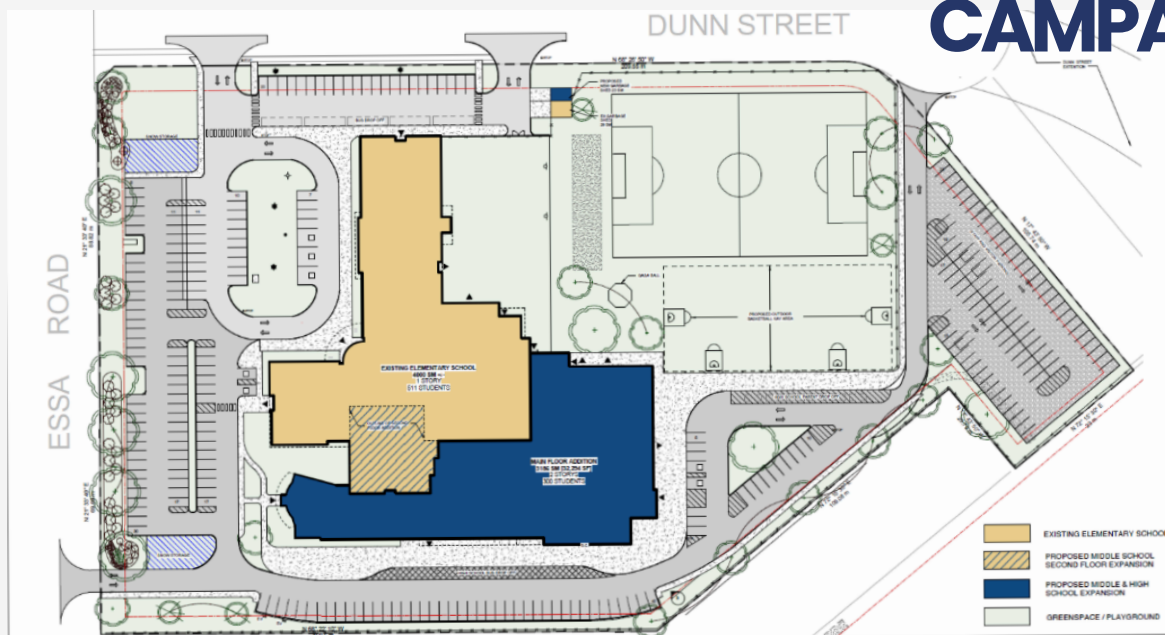
From the earliest years through graduation, students will experience a seamless journey of learning, faith, and belonging within one shared environment.
